



Dear Parent,

We would like to invite you to an Open House for our new after-school program. IMPACT Youth is designed to provide social and academic enrichment for students in grades in 6-12. Impact Youth is a partnership between Seneca Mentoring Youth Links (SMYL) and Little Faith Ministries. The after school program is located in the basement of Little Faith Ministries at 230 S. Washington St. The program will combine academic assistance, social skills, character education, physical activity, the “arts” and community service.

The Open House will be Tuesday, September 6th through Friday September 9th from 3-6pm daily. Parents and students will be given tours of the facility, meet the staff, ask questions and get registered for the program. Students are welcome to come each day next week during the Open House and participate with staff and volunteers. The full program will begin on Monday, September 12th at 3 p.m. and will run Monday-Friday from 3-6pm. In order to enroll in the program, you must submit your child’s application and the proper emergency medical/liability forms. The forms are available at the Open House, through your school guidance counselors or by accessing them at [www.senecasmyl.org](http://www.senecasmyl.org). Students who are enrolled in the program are expected to be there each day, unless you specify that your child is involved in other activities on a certain day. This is a FREE program, but it is not a “drop-in” program.
